#### Notes

Each person is counted only once, regardless of whether they hold multiple jobs/positions in one or more departments. This census only counts those who had active jobs or were on leave on the snapshot date. A primary appointment algorithm is used to determine which job/job type to count each person in if they have more than one job.
